Directions

Score each factor up to 10 points where 10 =outstanding, 7 =very good, 5 =good, 3 =average, and 0 =not pleasant. Add the scores in all five categories to the 50 points base score to get a rating on a 100-point scale.

Scoring

Aroma - An outstanding wine should be full of varying smells that entice you towards that first taste.

Initial Taste - This score represents your initial impression upon tasting the wine.

Second Taste - Because your senses adjust, the second taste is equally important.

Finish - Flavors will linger, change, and become more complex in an outstanding wine.

Overall - This is a subjective score based on how you like the wine.
